MISSION & GOALS

The Clothes Less Traveled Thrift Shop, Inc. (CLT) is a not-for-profit 501(C)3 organization. The Thrift Shop was established in January, 1997. The mission of the Board of Directors is to offer volunteer and community service opportunities, as well as grant funds to not-for-profit organizations throughout Fayette County and the surrounding region. Since January 1997, the Clothes Less Traveled Thrift Shop has donated over \$570,000 to needy organizations, including over 50 scholarships. The maximum value of this Scholarship is \$5000.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicant must be a 2010 graduating Senior from any Public or Private School, or Home-Schooled.
- Applicant must have volunteered a minimum of 40 hours at The Clothes Less Traveled between June 1, 2009 and March 13, 2010.

PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1. The scholarship check shall be made payable to the post-secondary educational institution and mailed to the institution prior to the beginning of the school year. The check, along with a letter of transmittal, shall be mailed to the Financial Aid Office at the recipient's institution. (It is the responsibility of the student to whom the Scholarship is awarded to send, in writing, the name of the institution as well as the student I.D. number to the Scholarship Selection Committee of Clothes Less Traveled).**
- 2. In the case that the recipient drops out or reduces credit hours, the institution will be requested to return to Clothes Less Traveled any appropriate refund.**
- 3. The Scholarship funds shall be used by the recipients, for the following and in the order listed:**
 - a. To pay tuition, fees and other mandatory fees;**
 - b. To pay for room and board charges at the institution;**
 - c. To purchase books and supplies at the institution;**
 - d. After the above has been satisfied, any remaining funds in the annual award may be disbursed directly to the student for personal expenses related to attendance at the institution only.**
- 4. Students may transfer from one institution to another as long as the institution to which he/she is transferring is accredited and the institution from which he/she is transferring is willing to either refund any unused portion of the award to the Clothes Less Traveled or to forward any unused portion of the award to the institution to which the student is transferring.**
- 5. Students are normally expected to be continuously enrolled in school (except for summer sessions). Clothes Less Traveled may approve limited "stop-outs" upon written justifications.**
